Student eligibility is based on the following eligibility criteria. The student:

- must be a resident of the Commonwealth of Kentucky;
- must be a Re-Entry Participant
- shall not have any current imposed enforcement action from the Division of Regulation and licensing board;
- must be eligible to enroll in the Kentucky-approved initial certification program at SFRT4;

How to Apply:

To apply for the EMT Re-entry Scholarship, students must submit the following information to the Re-Entry Board:

- A completed Re-Entry Scholarship Application
- A current resume
- A one- or two-page essay describing why you believe you should receive this scholarship and how receiving this scholarship will affect your education and life
- A copy of all transcripts
- Two letters of recommendation

Things to know:

- The scholarship is not from KCTCS, it is from the State Fire Rescue Training Area 4.
- It is for the attendance of the EMT class only at KCTCS.
- There are specific qualifications and that the applicant will have to interview with the State Fire Rescue Training Area 4 Director.
- All final candidates will have to have the final approval of the State Fire Rescue Training Area 4 Director.

Application Deadlines

The re-entry scholarship application is accepted on a rolling basis.
