Scholarship Purpose

The **Community Scholarship** provides financial support for:

- College or technical school tuition
- GED testing and preparation fees
- Vocational or workforce certification programs
- Tools, uniforms, books, or other materials needed for education or employment
- Expungement Fees
- Other Needs

Who Can Apply?

Applicants must:

- Reside in the 10-county region in **Southern Kentucky**
- Be a formerly incarcerated individual **or** an immediate family member impacted by incarceration
- Demonstrate financial need and a clear educational or career goal
- Show commitment to personal growth and community engagement

Award Details

- Scholarship Amount: **\$500 – \$1,000** (number of awards may vary depending on funding)
- Funds are paid directly to the school, training program, or vendor.
- Recipients will be recognized publicly by the Southern Kentucky Reentry Council.
